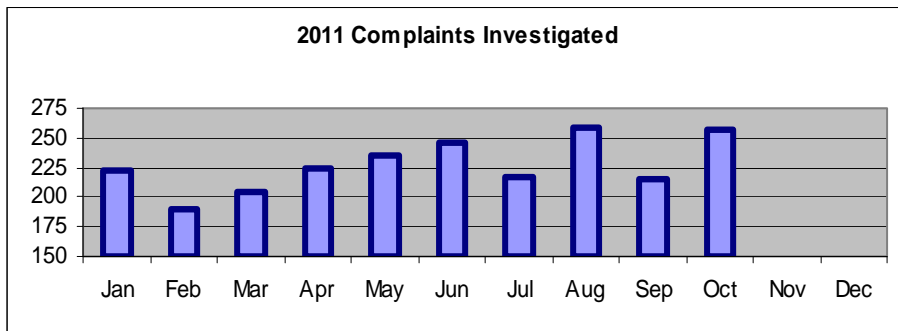
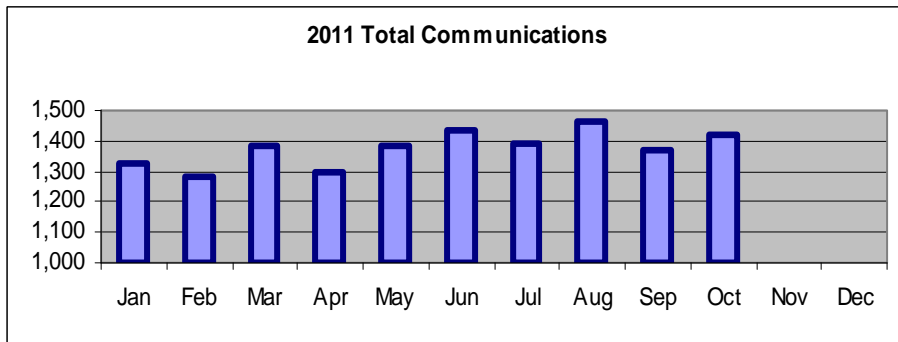



12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- On October 5th, officers from Franconia Township, Souderton, and the Montgomery County Detectives executed a search warrant on a home on Fox Hunt Drive where drug dealing had been suspected. A 26 year old man was taken into custody and charged with possession with the intent to deliver a large amount of heroin that was found in the home.
- Officers participated in their semi-annual firearms qualifications during the month of October.
- Chief Kozeniewski gave a presentation at the Hidden Springs Homeowners Association meeting on October 20th. He addressed their concerns about evacuation plans during events such as Hurricane Irene. Additionally, the Chief gave an overview of the emergency planning process locally, statewide, and nationally.
