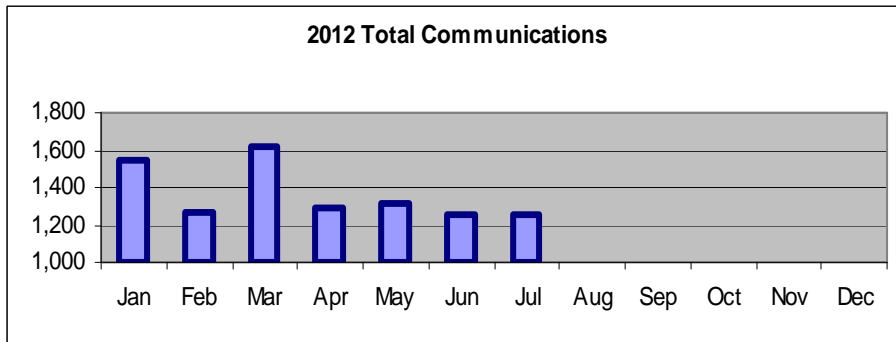



12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- Officers Brian Kelly & Glenn Kranich participated in training on the enforcement of new vehicle inspection laws. The presentation was made by instructors from PennDOT.
- Officer Tim Boyle received a Certificate of Achievement from the Southeast Pennsylvania Chapter of Mothers Against Drunk Driving for his exemplary DUI enforcement during the past year.
