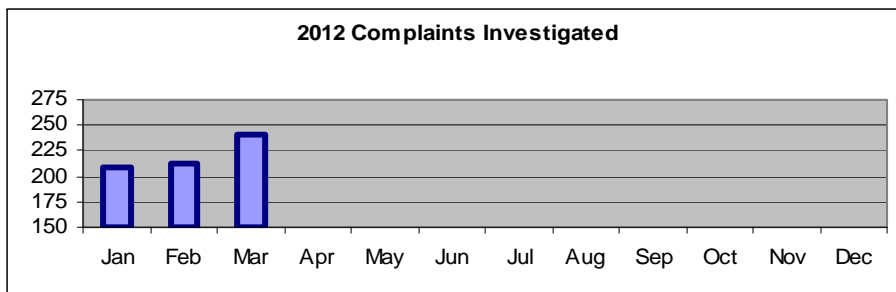
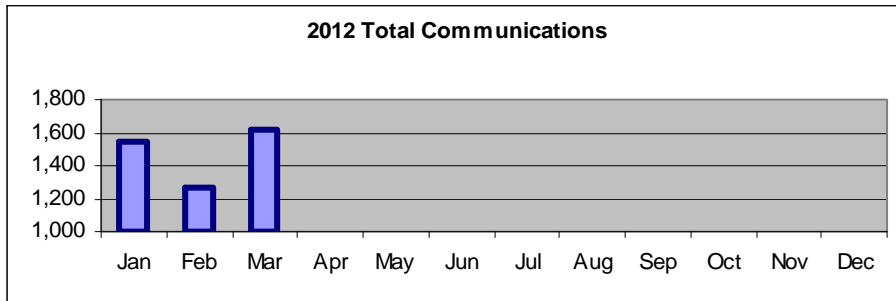



12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- Officers Kranich and Hinnershitz participated in their monthly training with the North Penn Tactical Response Team.
- There were two attempted burglaries and two actual burglaries of homes in the township during the month. All of the incidents occurred during the late morning to mid-afternoon hours. These incidents are similar to numerous other break-ins that have occurred in the northwest and north central parts of Montgomery County over the past two months. Our investigators have been sharing information with officers from the other police agencies that have experienced daytime burglaries.
