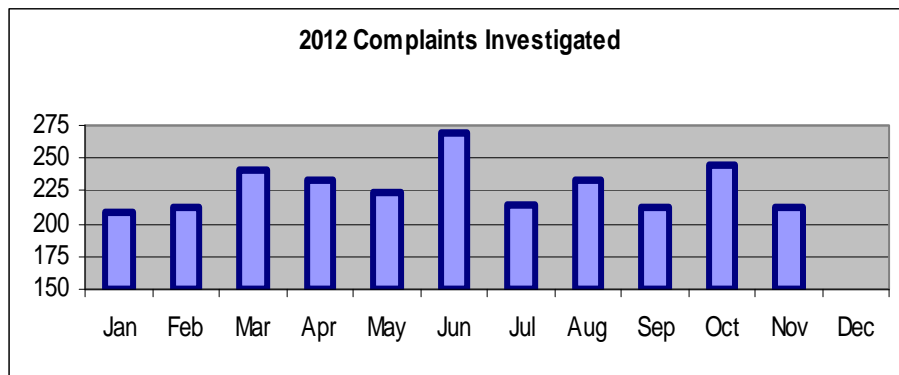
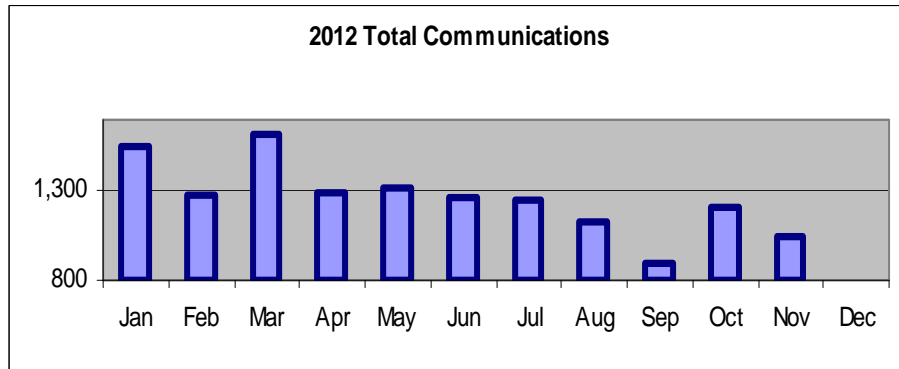

## 12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- The final group of officers attended the mandatory annual police training update classes in November. All department officers have now been trained in the changes in the laws and court decisions for 2012.
