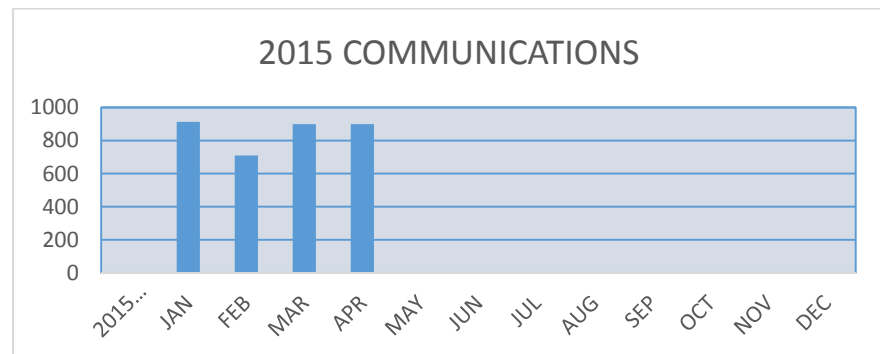
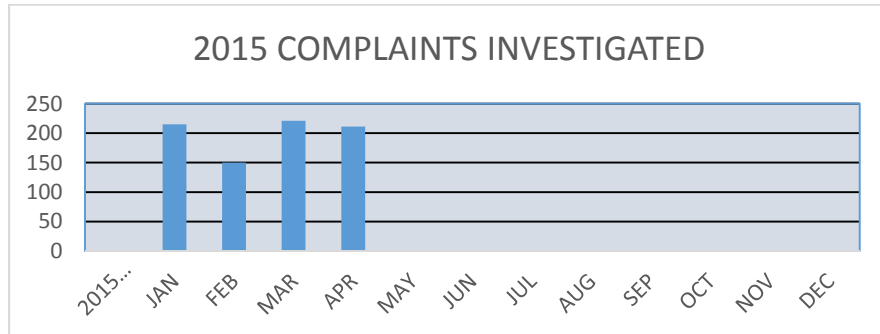



- On April 15th members of the police department received their annual certification training in First Aid and CPR.
- Officer Dave Klepfer made a presentation to the residents of the Peter Becker Community on safe driving habits for senior citizens. This took place on April 20th.
- On the same day, our officers responded to a home invasion robbery that took place on Comice Court in Pear Tree Village. It appears that this home was targeted by the actors for the robbery. The resident was held at gunpoint and received minor injuries. Cash was taken from the home. We are working with other law enforcement agencies in the Philadelphia region to identify the two men who committed the crime.
- On April 27th, Detective Sergeant George Moyer and Officer Glenn Kranich attended training for applying for search warrants and obtaining investigative information from cell phones.
