

- On November 23<sup>rd</sup>, Chief Kozeniewski, Detective George Moyer III, and Officer Steve Cronin participated in an orientation briefing for the new Mission Kids office in East Norriton Township. Mission Kids was created, in part, by District Attorney Risa Ferman to provide a single site in which to interview victims of child abuse and to coordinate the efforts of all investigating agencies.
- In November the Police Department was selected by the National Association of Town Watch as a National Award Winner for our National Night Out Against Crime celebration, which was held on Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
