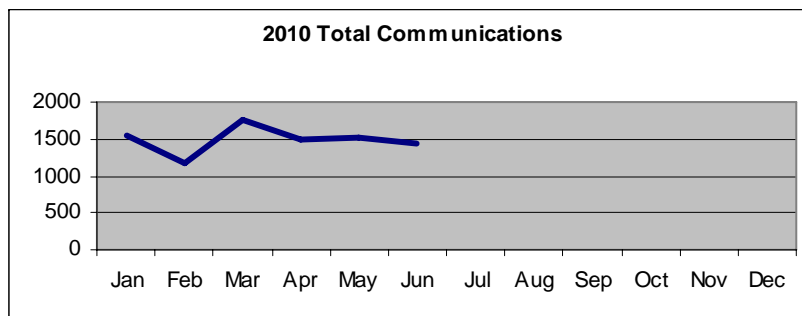
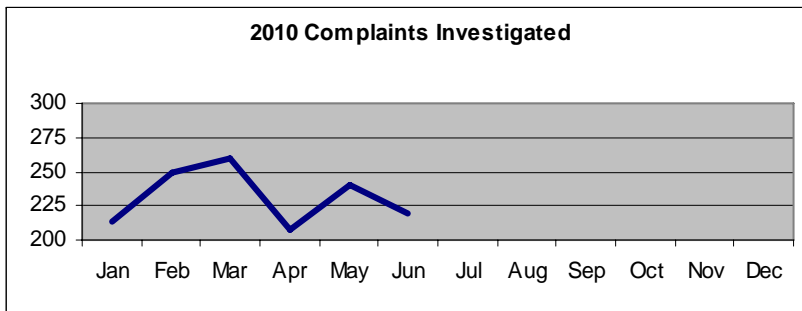



- On June 14th, assessors from the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association conducted an on-site review of the department's policies and procedures. As a result, the police department has achieved status as an Accredited Department for law enforcement agencies.
