

# 1. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITES DURING THE MONTH

- The Franconia Police Citizens Police Academy held its inaugural class on September 21<sup>st</sup>. Twenty-one township residents are attending the Academy which is being held on six consecutive Wednesday nights.
