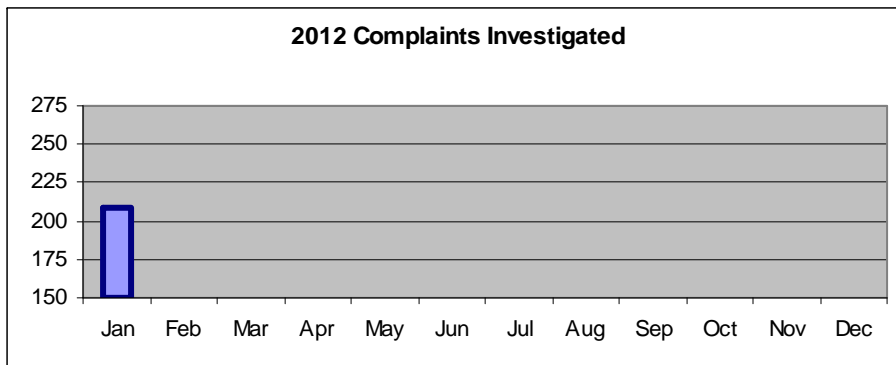
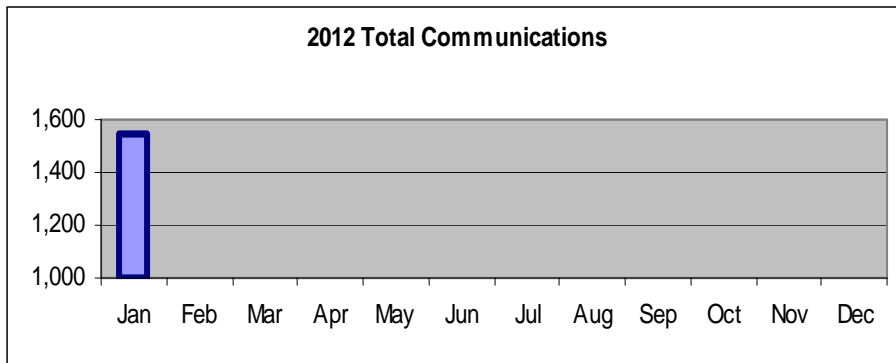



12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- On January 10th, Franconia Township Police officers assisted the Telford Police Department with a barricaded gunman who was holding a hostage inside a home in Indian Valley Lane. The gunman did discharge four rifle rounds through the front wall of the house. He eventually surrendered peacefully after negotiations with Chief Floyd.
- A representative from the Horsham Clinic provided an informational session about the services that they provide for juveniles who are in a crisis situation and require hospitalization. Protocols for officers were explained.
- Cpl. Stephen Rinker attended a meeting at the County Training Center that was presented by the U. S. Secret Service on January 27th. That agency provided advance info for law enforcement on expected visits to the county this year by the presidential candidates.
