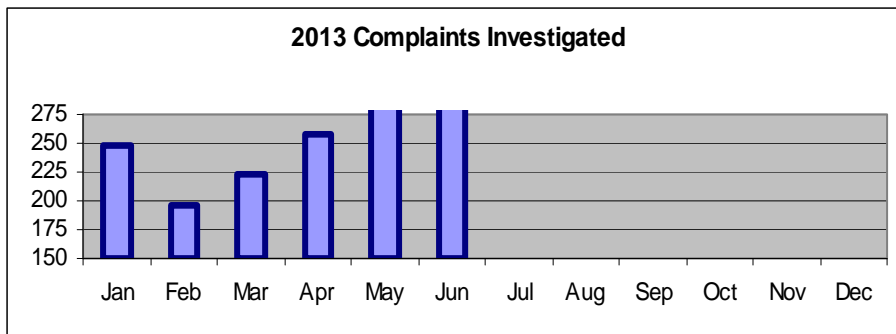
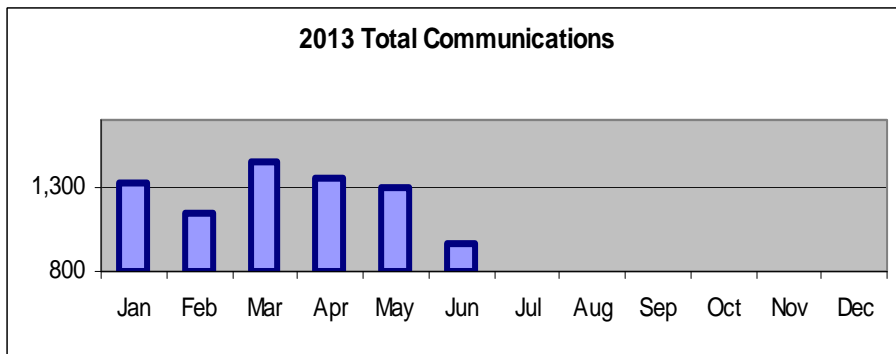



- Detective Sergeant George H. Moyer III attended the FBI Law Enforcement Executive Development Seminar at Princeton University during the week of June 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Chief Kozeniewski attended the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police conference on June 26<sup>th</sup> where he was presented with the new credentials for the department's achievement of earning Re-Accredited status for the statewide Police Accreditation Program.
