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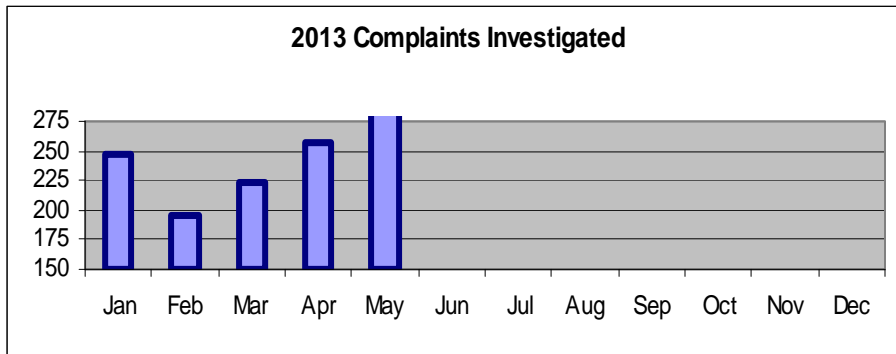
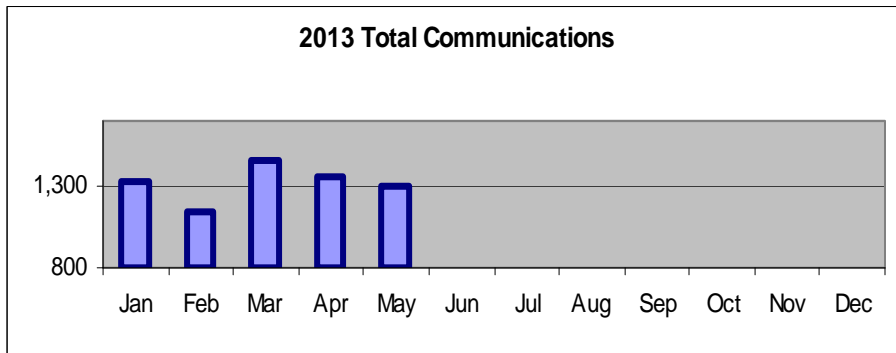

12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- On Saturday, May 11th, the department hosted its first Special Needs Open House at the police department building. It was organized by Administrative Assistant Janice Frary. Residents who have family members with special needs, with a special emphasis on autistic children, were invited to meet and greet members of the police department, Telford Volunteer Fire Company, and Souderton Community Ambulance in a non-threatening atmosphere. Food donations and other activities were provided by local businesses.
- Officer Kurt DeForrest earned his certification as a Police Field Training Officer during the week of May 13th.
- The department hosted the three assessors from the Pennsylvania Chiefs Accreditation Program on May 23rd and 24th. After a review of all of the required files and department practices, the team approved the certification of the department's Accredited Status for the next three years.
- A DUI Checkpoint was conducted on May 31st in conjunction with the North Penn DUI Task Force. The detail was conducted between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. on Harleysville Pike near Moyer Road. Officers charged eight persons for driving while under the influence and cited two others for public drunkenness.
