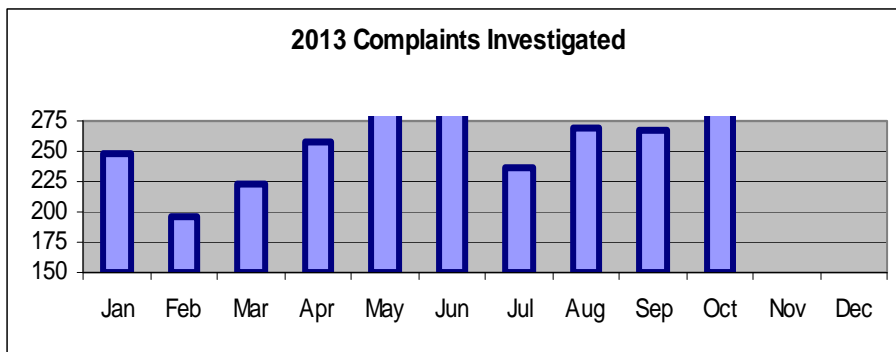
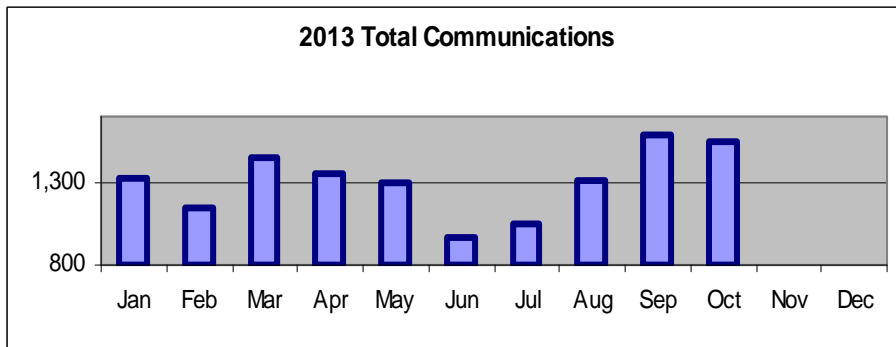



Parents accompanied their children from Broad Street & Washington Avenue in Souderton to the school while walking on the sidewalks on West Broad Street. The event was held on October 9<sup>th</sup>.
- On October 13<sup>th</sup>, Officer Jess Whiteside represented the police department at the Telford Fire Company's Annual Open House celebration.
- Chief Kozeniewski, Sergeants Rinker and Moyer, as well as Corporal Hall attended various training sessions at the 120<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference of the International Association of Chiefs of Police. The conference was held in Philadelphia from October 20<sup>th</sup> through the 23<sup>rd</sup>. This was a rare chance for our officers to experience training on global and local issues that are facing law enforcement. The sessions were conducted by nationally-recognized experts in policing.
- On October 26<sup>th</sup>, the department participated in the semi-annual Prescription Drug Take-Back program. Throughout the day, numerous residents deposited their unwanted prescription drugs into our collection bin in our front lobby.
