



#### 12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITES DURING THE MONTH

- On May 7<sup>th</sup>, officers from the department received their recertification training for the Montgomery County District Attorney's Drug Task Force. Our officers are trained to conduct drug investigations locally as part of a county-wide team effort.
- Township Manager Jon Hammer and Chief Kozeniewski were the guest speakers at the monthly meeting of the Lion's Gate Homeowners Association on May 13th.
- During the late evening of Friday, May 22nd, the department conducted a DUI Checkpoint on Harleysville Pike near Moyer Road. The detail resulted in the arrest of two drivers for driving while under the influence while seven other drivers were not permitted to drive further because they showed signs of impairment. The checkpoint is funded by the Department of Transportation and held in conjunction with other members of the North Penn DUI Task Force.
