On Thursday afternoon, July 30, 2009, Franconia Township police officers arrested a man wanted for a parole violation, escape, and a weapons offense.

Lloyd I. Davis, 28, with no fixed address, was taken into custody based on warrants from the Pennsylvania Board of Parole and Probation and the Pennsylvania State Police.

Davis had been observed in the area of the Heatherfield section of Franconia Township earlier that morning. Later in the day, officers received information that he was at a residence on the 300 block of Heatherfield Drive.

Shortly thereafter, officers observed Davis walking along the roadway. When approached by the police, he ran into the Hunters Green neighborhood, where he was taken into custody. Officers from the Souderton Police Department and the Hatfield Township Police Department assisted the Franconia officers with the apprehension.

Davis was turned over to the State Police at the Franconia Township Police Department when they arrived with a warrant for their charges.
