Subjects Arrested During Overnight Traffic Stop

On Tuesday, February 6, 2006 at 11:13 p.m., Franconia Township police officers stopped a black Chevrolet Lumina for a moving violation in the area of Elroy Road near Derstine Road in Franconia Township.

Officers identified the driver of the Chevrolet as Dean Lukens, 20, of the 500 block of Park Avenue in Harleysville. While officers were speaking with Lukens, they detected the strong odor of burnt marijuana coming from the vehicle. After an investigation, police arrested Lukens for possession of a controlled substance. Lukens was arrested and later released. Charges will be filed in the near future.

The passenger in the vehicle was identified as Tywuan Hendricks, 24, of the 200 block of Noble Street in Souderton. After providing police with a false name and information, Hendricks was arrested for unsworn falsification to law enforcement. It was also learned that there were active warrants for his arrest from both Bucks County and Lehigh County.

Hendricks was arraigned in front of District Court Justice Harold Borek in Lansdale on Wednesday, February 7, 2007 and turned over to the Bucks County Sheriff's Department.
