YOUR PERMIT FEE COVERS THE COSTS OF STANDARD INSPECTIONS. AN ADDITIONAL INSPECTION FEE OF \$35.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR EACH ADDITIONAL INSPECTION APPOINTMENTS, INCOMPLETE WORK OR REPAIRS, OR OTHER DELAYS CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR/APPLICANT.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

PLEASE NOTE: The permit conditions listed below are to be considered part of the permit and must be adhered to. Failure to do so will result in the issuance of a <u>notice of violation</u>, cease and <u>desist order</u>, or <u>citation</u>. A copy of the permit and these conditions <u>must</u> be supplied to any subsequent lot owner at the time of settlement or transfer.

THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS:

- 1. DURING CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO HAVE PROPER ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS PERFORMED BY A QUALIFIED INSPECTOR. THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING INSPECTOR WILL CONDUCT PLUMBING INSPECTIONS.
- 2. PRIOR TO COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION AND ISSUANCE OF OCCUPANY PERMIT, THE CONTRACTOR MUST SUPPLY THE BUILDING INSPECTOR WITH AN INSPECTION CERTIFICATE (e.g. CUT CARD) FROM A QUALIFIED UNDERWRITER THAT THE ELECTRICAL INSPECTION HAS BEEN ACCOMPLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST AND APPLICABLE CODES.
- **3.** A.C. powered and inter-connected smoke detectors, with battery back-up, are required on every level and in every bedroom. Heat detectors in garage and attic are to be interconnected to smoke detectors.
- **4.** All glass 24" from door, or within 18" of the floor must be tempered or of safety type. This includes tub and shower enclosures.
 - **a.** All glass that is 10 feed above a floor, regardless of size, must be safety glass, tempered glass, or approved plastic.
 - **b.** All skylights, regardless of location, must be safety glass, tempered glass or approved plastic.
 - **c.** Any glass within a shower or tub area must be safety or tempered glass.
- **5.** If applicable; chimney and fireplace to be constructed as per codes.
- 6. All stairs to have handrails and guardrails. Guardrails-no opening larger than 4".
 - **a.** Minimum headroom for stairways is 80".
 - **b.** Maximum rise 7 ¾", minimum tread 10" nose to nose.
- 7. Garage walls and ceiling separating garage from house, must be covered with one hour fire rated drywall, minimum. This includes 2 layers of 5/8" type X fire rated drywall. All remaining garage walls require one layer 5/8" type X fire rated drywall.

- **8.** All walls to be provided with firestopping.
- **9.** Door and frame between house and garage must be <u>labeled</u> for minimum one hour fire rating.
- **10.** All concrete slabs between the house and garage must be 4" minimum step-up into house.
- 11. Maximum backfill permitted on 8" CMU wall or poured concrete 4 feet.
- **12.** Maximum backfill permitted on 10" CMU wall or poured concrete 5 feet.
- **13.** Maximum backfill permitted on 12" CMU wall or poured concrete 7 feet.
- **14.** Use of lead in plumbing construction or repairs is prohibited.
- **15.** All plumbing and water fixtures must comply with the Township Water Conservation Ordinance (Ordinance # 138) and as amended by (Ordinance # 186).
- **16.** Outdoor burning prohibited except when permitted by Burning Ordinance.
- **17.** Bedrooms <u>must</u> provide for proper window egress per 2006 International Building Code.
- **18.** Driveway permits as required.
- **19.** Silt fence must be in place before excavation, if applicable.
- **20.** All lots will be required to conform to the Sedimentation and Erosion Control Plan.
- **21.** Carbon Monoxide detectors are required when pre-fabricated fireplaces are used.
- 22. Contact Township for other rules and regulations.
