Supervisor Fazio motioned and Supervisor Kratz seconded the motion. Approved 4-0

POLICE REPORT- CHIEF JOSEPH S. KOZENIEWSKI

Chief Kozeniewski submitted his report, and announced that there were only 4 reportable accidents in the last month and no injuries. He stated that the new traffic patterns would begin next week along the 113 bridge over the PA Turnpike.
