MORWOOD AREA PUBLIC SEWER

The Morwood Area public sewer project is nearing completion. Informational letters, along with invoices, are being mailed to residents as public sewer becomes available for their connection. A list of property addresses that can connect is provided in the "ConnectionAvailable" link below (these are property addresses and not necessarily mailing addresses). Immediate connection to public sewer is not required unless (per Township ordinance):

- 1) Your on-lot system has failed or is failing
- 2) Your on-lot system requires repairs
- 3) Your property is changing owners

Connection to public sewer requires that you:

- Fill out a Lateral Permit Application this is provided in the "SewerApp_fillin" link below; the homeowner or their installer can fill out the application – make sure to include a sketch of the sewer location and planned sewer line route. You only need to complete the highlighted items
- A sample Lateral Permit Application is provided in the "SewerApp_Sample" link below, and includes a sample sketch
- 3) Email (<u>gwitmayer@franconia-township.org</u>) or drop-off in the mailbox at the left entrance of the Township building the completed Lateral Permit Application
- 4) Payment of all sewer fees (as indicated on your invoice) is expected at the time you get your permit. Once the permit application and fees have been collected, Authority personnel will mail or drop-off your permit. At that point your installer can pick up a pump from the Township (if you are purchasing it from us) and construction can begin. If you are in the process of selling your property please contact the Authority for additional assistance.

A list of companies that have employees who've been certified is provided in the "CertifiedInstallers" link below. The pump manufacturer is providing an additional three-year guarantee on top of their normal two-year guarantee for those installers that have taken the manufacturers course and agree to install the pumps in accordance with their requirements. However, anyone can install the pump and sewer lateral – the installation must meet Township requirements and will be inspected before being allowed to be put into service.

Most residential properties will be using the E|One DH071 pump. Properties having more than two EDUs are required to use the E|One DH152 pump.
